McKinnon Dance Spring Points by the Shore Competition Rules

1. No refunds will be granted.
2. Numbers to be picked up at the registration desk.
3. Late entries may not appear in the program.
4. First to enter; last to dance. Dancer numbers will be available at the registration desk
5. SOBHD cards must be presented or awards will be withheld.
6. McKinnon Dance will follow the rules and regulations set forth by SOBHD.
7. Dancers will be judged according to the technique of SOBHD. Judges decision is final. No access to judge's sheets.
8. Scrutineering shall be conducted as recommended by SOBHD.
9. Dancers must report promptly when called to the lineup area or risk disqualification.
10. Protests may be lodged to McKinnon Dance according to the rules of SOBHD.
11. McKinnon Dance is not responsible for accidents, injuries, or lost articles.
12. Dancers must be in full dress (including slippers) to receive awards.

She opened a dance studio on Emerald PEI in 2000.

Barbara is actively involved in ScotDance Canada as a member of the Board of Directors. She is the Executive Member for PEI and President of ScotDance PEI, roles she also held from 1995 to 2003, before resuming them in 2005.
