COMPETITION RULES

1. Absolutely no phone or fax entries. Absolutely No Field Entries. Late entries at organizers discretion. PLEASE SEND ENTRIES for due date (With the P.O. Box ~ we have some small issues with mail being received on time).
2. A dancer may not register for additional dances or change category on the day of the competition – this MUST BE EMAILED IN TO ENTER. NO FAXED ENTRIES. NO PHONE ENTRIES.
3. First to enter, last to dance.
4. SOBHD dancer registration cards must be presented or awards will be withheld.
5. This association will follow the rules and regulations as set forth by SOBHD.
6. Dancers shall be judged according to technique of SOBHD. Scrutineering shall be conducted as recommended by SOBHD.
7. Competitors must report promptly to dance area when event is called. Failure to appear on stage in registered to dance order will mean automatic disqualification from that dance.
8. Protests may be lodged to the association responsible for the event according to the SOBHD rules.
9. **Dancers are asked to be in full dress (including slippers) to receive awards.**
10. Judges' decision is final.
11. No refunds of registration fees unless a conflict of a judge's student having entered should occur.
12. This association will not be responsible or liable for lost articles, injuries, or illness to competitors or spectators.
13. Medals will be awarded from Primary to Premier categories. Cash prizes will be awarded to the oldest Adult Premier Class. Trophies will be awarded for highest aggregate winners except for Primary Class.
14. High aggregate trophies will be awarded to dancers with highest dance points, based upon medals awarded.
*This excludes the *Primary Category* ~ No High Aggregate in this category.

No refunds after entries received.

Dancers will pick up numbers at registration table upon verification of SOBHD card.

Dancing rules and scrutineering will be as recommended by SOBHD. Judge's decision is final. No access to judges' result sheets. In the event of a protest being lodged, a \$25.00 fee must accompany the written complaint and must be postmarked & forwarded within a period of 7 days. This fee will be returned if the protest is upheld.

Dancer age will be as of the date of competition. Classes will be decided based on the number of entries.

The Gaelic College will not be responsible for any lost articles, injuries or accidents to contestants or spectators.

No coaching by teachers or parents while dancers are on stage. Parents are not to be in the line up area unless working there.
